- We will break for lunch from 12-12:30pm
- From 12:30-2pm all groups will be spilt into two areas: the Courtyard and the Pond
 - Specific needs for the Courtyard and Pond will be developed
 - o The Executive Council is working on developing an outdoor classroom in the Courtyard area
 - o Clubs are encouraged to "adopt a box" in the Courtyard

- "Loaner tools" like rakes, wheel barrels, shovels etc.
- Donations of things like work gloves, cases of water etc.
